Under the Maharashtra Self-financing Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 J. P. K. Pratishtan, Ahmedpur, from the academic year 2023-24, Samarth Public School and Junior College, Gat/Suv. No. 104, village Malegaon (Kh.), Tah. Ahmedpur, Dist. Latur (Primary to Higher Secondary, etc. 1st to 12th, English Medium, All Branches, State Board) has submitted an application for starting a new school on self-financing basis.

2. With reference to your application, from the academic year 2023-24 J. P. K. Pratishtan, Ahmedpur Directed Samarth Public School and Junior College, Gat/Suv. No. 104, village Malegaon (Kh.), Tah. Ahmedpur, Dist. Latur (Primary to Higher Secondary, etc. 1st to 12th, English Medium, All Branches, State Board) was given Letter of Intent to start construction of the school on self-financing basis with terms and conditions. The approval to start the said school, is being given as subject to the following terms and being conditions.

### 3. Terms and Conditions:-

- 1) The proposed school shall comply with all standards, terms and conditions prescribed by the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Maharashtra Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 and the directions issued by the Government under this Act or as specified by the Government from time to time will meet the terms & conditions.
- 2) The registered institution or trust or company shall comply with all the standards, terms and conditions prescribed by the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act,2012 and the directions issued by the Government under this Act or the standards or terms and conditions specified by the Government from time to time.

3) CBSE or CISCE or C.A.I.E. or I.B. etc, it is mandatory for the school management of the Board, to obtain a no-objection certificate (NOC) from the Government as per the instructions issued by the Government from time to time.

4) The school management shall inform the concerned District Education Officer before the commencement of the academic year as approved by the Government.

5) Permission granted under the provisions of this Act to establish a new school or upgrade a school shall be for the academic year for which it is granted.

6) If the school management, within 18 months, fails to start the school, provided The approval letter will be cancelled.

7) The school management, approved medium of education, location of the school cannot be changed in future without the permission of the Government.

8) If the school management establishes a school at a place other than the place approved by the Government, the permission of that school shall be cancelled.

9) It has been provided that the recruitment of teachers and non-teaching staff in self-financing schools should be done in accordance with the prevailing rules and regulations of the Government.

10) While filling district wise information, the school to which permission has been given shall fill the information as "Self-financing School" as a separate category and it will get U.D.I.S.E. number in this regard, state project director, Maharashtra council primary education, Mumbai has been declared as the nodal officer.

11) The school management shall put up a signboard at the entrance of the school premises as "Self-financed Govt. Permitted."

12) The state Government may, at any time can cancel the letter of approval on the ground of any of the provision of this act or of the rules made there under or failure to comply with any directions issued under the act or standards, or terms and conditions specified by the Government from time to time.
